After a warm welcome of our hosts a spectacular show with real time programming of a trip from Lucerne into the universe was presented: an unforgettable space walk to planets, galaxies and stars. Monday 25 September we started with a welcome coffee at the Swiss Museum of Transport (VHS), Lucerne.



The introduction was followed by a guided tour through the VHS.



The lunch was organized on a cruise ship including a round-trip on Lake Lucerne. After the lunch the keynote speaker: MICHAEL FIRNHABER, CEO Google Switzerland introduced the interesting question "Google from platform to partnership?" 

## **26th September**

The program of Tuesday 26 September consisted of a study tour "Gotthard yesterday, today and tomorrow". We traveled by train to the SBB Historic Erstfeld depot of vintage locomotives, where we had a guided tour, and continued the journey via the legacy line in vintage rolling stock to GÖSCHENEN. A traditional Swiss lunch was served at the Göschenen station buffet.



After the lunch a guided tour through the historically significant GOTTHARD TUNNEL village Göschenen was organized. We walked by foot through the historic tunnel builders village. The train through the old Gotthard tunnel brought us to BELLINZONA (Canton Ticino) where old Mail busses were waiting for us to bring us to the CASTELLO SASSO CORBARO one of the three impressive castels of Bellinzona with a magnificent view. In this castle we could visit an interesting exposition organized by KILIAN ELSASSER himself an IATM member. The evening meal with local specialties was served at the CASTLEGRANDE. Our return trip by train through the Gotthard base tunnel, the world's longest railway tunnel (57 km), to LUCERNE was the final highlight of the day.
